



### The Halland Model

#### **Outcome**

1,100 = One third of all construction workers trained in traditional techniques

235 new jobs

100 historic buildings conserved

500 MSEK (55 M€)

(Halland 300,000 Inhabitants)



#### **Economic**

- obvious return on the investments moreover contributed
- regional growth
- created jobs

#### Social

- regional cohesion
- developed cross-sectoral networks and a multi-problem-oriented approach
- strengthened the local identity

#### **Environmental**

- take hand on existing resources
- environmental friendly materials were used
- energy efficiency



## Trading Zone

- Trading zones, in which scientific subcultures, each with its own language, develop the equivalents of pidgin and creole;
- A trading zone can gradually become a NEW AREA OF EXPERTISE, facilitated by interactional expertise and involving negotiations over boundary objects (objects represented in different ways by different participants).
- In the field of studies of history and sociology of science, Peter Galison introduced the concept of trading zone as a useful instrument for understanding INNOVATION PROCESSES in the field of science.
- Full agreement is not therefore necessary. What allows the completion
  of a project is a limited agreement which may have different meanings
  for each party.



## Trading Zone

- What the concept of TZ adds to planning theory?
- Planning as the work of creating preconditions for the development of TZ
- The production of a vision could be seen an act of communication which tends to create shared local understanding
- Planning must be genuinely open to the change of context to take the opportunity of a possible action
- There must be a specific search for indirect results which may arise from casual combination like in the garbage can
- There must be a specific attention at the boundary strategies rather than at the core strategies
